Hi Julie,

SNRE heard limited testimony on S.259 this morning, and did not ask any questions of the witnesses (they ran out of time). The committee heard from Justin Mankin, a climate researcher at Dartmouth, who testified about the cost assessment methodology that the Treasurer could use. He stated that it is possible to determine costs to Vermont from a certain quantity of emissions, and noted that the methodology has been used to assess costs from extreme heat, but has not yet been applied to other hazards like flooding or droughts, mortality or morbidity . His materials are not posted yet, but I will share with the Treasurer once they are available.

I understand that the bill will be voted out of Finance this afternoon.
